

Invitation for Contractor

"817786 – WV | H2ALL | Call for Tender | Construction of Water Reservoirs and Well equipment".

Location: Ali el Nahri and Baaloul – Bekaa, Lebanon

H2ALL, a consortium comprised of the Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC) as the lead, in partnership with Gruppo di Volontariato Civile (GVC), Oxfam and World Vision (WV) has been formed to provide support to the vulnerable communities of several municipalities of the Bekaa region. The consortium will work together in close collaboration, using complementary skills and expertise in the planned sector of intervention. The proposed project will build on the experiences and lessons learned throughout the partners' related activities in the region. The consortium's overall goal is to contribute to the effective and sustainable multi-level water governance in crisis affected Lebanon. Through well-defined activities, the consortium members aim to promote sustainable water services and provide an enabling environment that improves living conditions of vulnerable Lebanese and Syrian refugee communities.

The purpose of this contract is to hire a contractor to support World Vision in construction of water reservoirs and transmission lines in Ali el Nahri and equipping a well in Baaloul Bekaa - Lebanon. The contractor shall execute the project in compliance to the Condition of contracts (Vol 01), technical specifications (Vol 02), bill of quantities (Vol 03) and tender drawings (Vol 04) received from World Vision Lebanon procurement department.

The project includes:

1. Construction of water reservoir with a capacity of 1000 m³ in Ali Nahri
2. Construction of water tower with a capacity of 300 m³ in Ali Al Nahri
3. Installation of around 4.88 km of transmission line in Ali Al Nahri
4. Well equipment in Baaloul

Eligible bidders are:

- Lebanese Contractors classified as First Degree Contractor for Water Project with the Ministry of Energy and Water,
- **and** five stars classified contractor with the CDR (roads, civil works, and buildings),
- **and** at least one successfully handed over water project of minimum value of two million U.S. dollars in the last five years and has successfully completed the execution of at least one elevated water tank similar to the work specified in the Bill of Quantities.
